

Our records show that you may be due for your diabetes eye exam.

Taking care of your eyes is very important. Diabetic retinopathy is the most common cause of new cases of blindness among adults aged 20-74 years. Eye problems like glaucoma and cataracts can take place earlier in people with diabetes. You can have the best vision if you get a dilated eye test once a year.

Things you should know about your eye benefits.

- Eye exam is covered for those with diabetes.
- · This is a benefit even if you do not have a vision benefit.



It's important to stay healthy. We're here to help you do just that.

At University of Utah Health Plans, we see health insurance from a different perspective – providing care that meets you right where you are.

Make sure to follow these simple guidelines to protect yourself from cancer. Screening tests can find abnormal cells early so they can be treated before they become cancer. If cancer is found, early treatment can save your life.

Our records show you may be overdue for one or more of the following cancer screenings:

Cervical Cancer Screening - Two tests are used to screen for corvical cancer: a Pap test and Human Papillomaviurs (HPV test). Women aged 21 through 65 should been screened regularly for cervical cancer.

Breast Cancer Screening: - A mammogram is an important tool for finding breast cancer early. Women age 50 to 74 years old should get a mammogram at least once every two years. For some women, breast cancer screening may start before age 50.

Talk with your doctor to make sure you are up to date with all your health screenings. If you need help finding a doctor, or scheduling a health screening, please call the Customer Service number on the back of your Member ID card, or visit <u>uhealthplan.utah.edu</u> to find a provider in your area.
